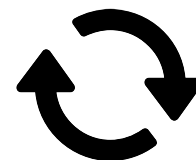
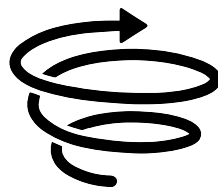


- ❗ Lack of Eye Contact
- ❗ Flapping, Flicking, Spinning
- ❗ Sensitive to Touch
- ❗ May Appear Stubborn/Resistant
- ❗ Scripting Words, Phrases, Noises
- ❗ Processing Delays

REPETITIVE BEHAVIORS

- Flapping, flicking, spinning, or rocking.
- Focuses on one topic/detail that is unrelated to the conversation.
- Scripting or repeating sounds (e.g., *repeat lines of a television show or movie*).



MENTAL PROCESSES

- Displays poor impulse control (e.g., *constantly touching an object despite being told/given consequences*).
- Processing delay/Unable to follow a chain of commands. (e.g., *put your coat on the chair, sit down, and put your phone on the table*).

SENSORY BEHAVIORS

- May be sensitive to touch, especially if unexpected.
- Overwhelmed by sensory environment (e.g., *covers ears, eyes, nose*).



SOCIAL COMMUNICATION

- Flat vocal affect (e.g., *voice stays at one tone with little to no inflection*).
- Unusual facial grimaces.
- Avoidance of eye contact or blank stare throughout conversation.
- Individual has no friends or is socially isolated.
- May appear stubborn, defiant, or non-compliant with requests.
- Atypical or stiff body language, flat facial expressions
- Overly literal interpretation of questions.
- Increased aggravation/anxiety during interview.
- Overly agreeable.
- Appears to have a lack of sympathy or empathy.
