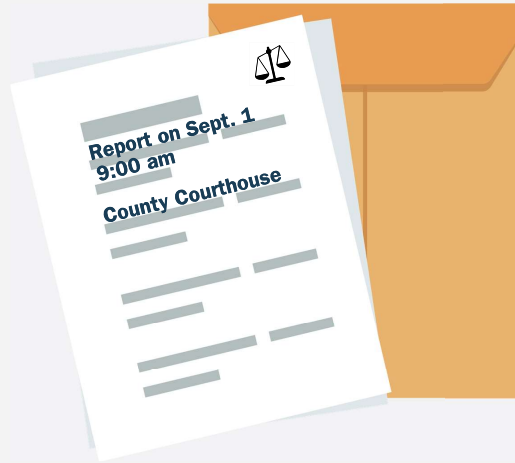


GETTING SUMMONED FOR JURY DUTY

I will need to go through a metal detector and put any items into a basket. I will get them back after they are scanned.



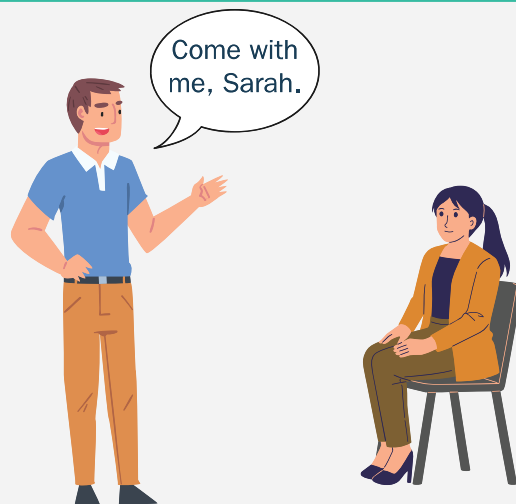
I will hand the front desk my forms and ID. Someone will tell me where to sit and wait.



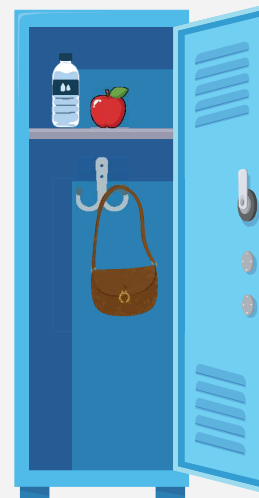
I may have to wait a long time. This could take a few hours or all day.
