Put together an emergency kit with pet food, water, medications, records and a first aid kit.



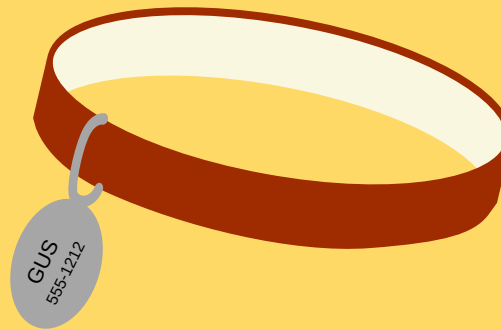
If you take care of livestock, plan for any trailers, food or halters.
