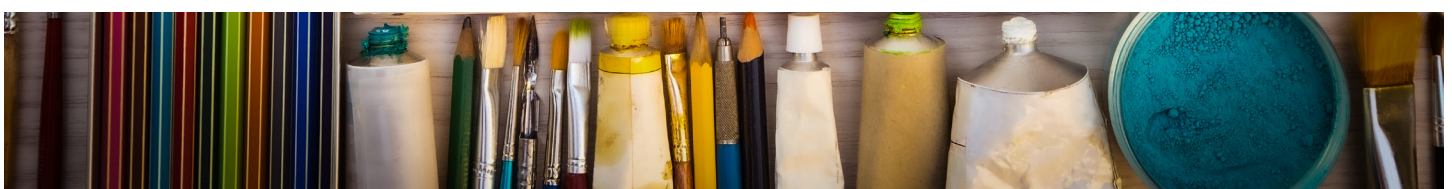
ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

Eligibility: The PATC Call for Art is open to Pennsylvania residents who are on the autism spectrum.

Deadline: Friday, September 1

Content Guidelines: Submissions must adhere to the following guidelines to be considered for the art show:

- Content should not include the use of profanity or vulgarity.
- Content should not include blood, violence, firearms, or injury.
- Content should not include sexualized imagery.
- Content should not promote hatred against, discrimination, disparage, or humiliate an individual or group of people.
- Content should not include imagery relating to recreational drugs or other drug-related content.
- Content should not include political themes.
- The review committee reserves the right to determine that artwork is not eligible to be part of the show if we find it exhibits any of these criteria or may be offensive to anyone viewing the work.
